Registration and Setup

- **Saturday Registration location: Krasl Art Center, 707 Lake Blvd., St. Joseph, MI**

Artists MUST Register Before Setting Up

Only the accepted primary artist or collaborator (whose name appears on the application) may register. Artist helpers cannot register. This is strictly enforced.

Required for Registration

1. **Picture ID**
2. **License Plate number**
3. **Cell Phone number**

What to do After Registration

- After you register, you may set up any time on Friday after 1:00 PM or Saturday from 6:00-10:00 AM. To ease parking congestion, a few south booths may be assigned staggered set-up times.
- Lake Boulevard will be ONE WAY during registration and set-up.
- Vehicles must enter Lake Boulevard at the light and travel NORTH to the bluff.
- You will receive a pink short-term parking pass at Registration.
- Please give the volunteer greeter your short term parking pass before you unload.

Setup

- A Volunteer Greeter wearing a Krasl Art Fair CREW t-shirt will greet you.
- Your Volunteer Greeter will welcome you and make sure you're in your assigned booth space and within the booth space boundaries. Your Greeter can also answer questions, provide you with information, and assist you with any other needs related to set-up.
- To ensure that you are in the correct booth space, please wait until the Greeter has confirmed your space before setting up.
- Place your pink parking pass on your dashboard while unloading.
- There is a two hour limit for unloading. This is strictly enforced.
- To unload, please park your vehicle diagonally on Lake Blvd., unload as quickly as possible, then remove your vehicle from Lake Blvd.
- You must move your vehicle before you set up.
- If you arrive after Friday Registration has closed, **YOU MUST WAIT TO REGISTER AND SET UP ON SATURDAY MORNING.**
