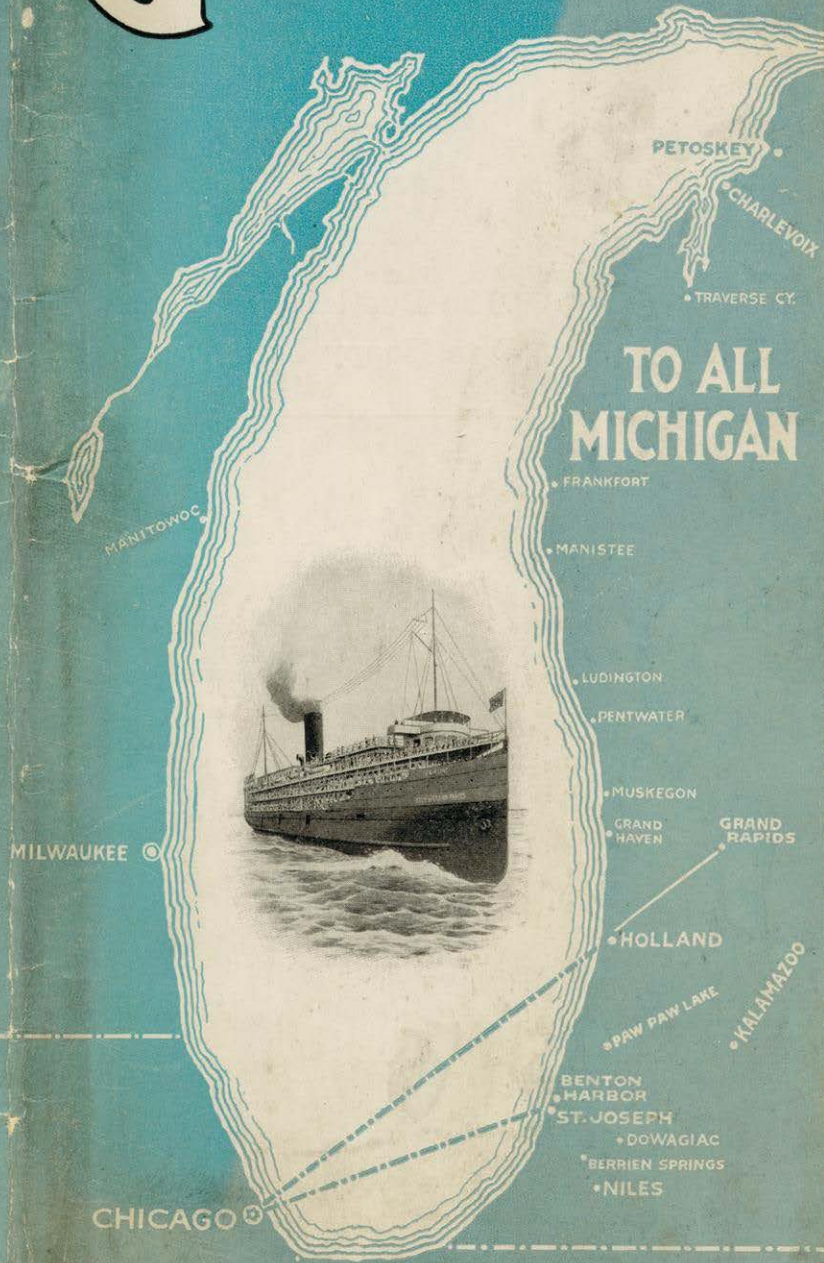

# FLY ACROSS LAKE MICHIGAN.

Aviator Vilas and His Companion Go  
from St. Joseph to Chicago.

CHICAGO, June 1.—Logan Vilas, an amateur aviator of Chicago, made to-day the first flight across Lake Michigan, going in a hydro-aeroplane from St. Joseph, Mich., to Chicago, in one hour and thirty-four minutes. Vilas was accompanied by William Bastar of Benton Harbor.

The aviator followed the steamship lane from St. Joseph to Chicago, a distance of 58 miles. He would have crossed within an hour, he said, had not shifting air currents compelled him frequently to change the level on which he was flying.
